for Leidschendam-Voorburg

## 1. Sustainable Leidschendam-Voorburg - Climate-conscious and green

- Climate neutral and climate proof by 2040.
- Acceleration of the energy transition and support for neighbourhood initiatives.
- More trees, greenery, and solutions to heat stress.
- Sustainable transport options take precedence over cars.
- Excellent traffic flow for cyclists and pedestrians.

## 2. A new economic perspective - balancing well-being and profit

- Broad prosperity and wellbeing are central.
- Support for local small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs).
- Circular and sustainable procurement by the municipality.
- Sport and culture as essential facilities that strengthen health and connection.

## 3. Equal opportunities for all - inclusive and supportive

- Creating more affordable homes through smart densification, with a special focus on first-time buyers and senior citizens
- Supporting mixed neighbourhoods, cooperative living and house sharing.
- The actual realisation of at least 30% social housing.
- Taking a strict approach to vacancy and malpractice in the housing market.
- Support neighbourhood initiatives and care cooperatives.
- One fixed and clear point of access to care and youth care, with an emphasis on prevention.
- Investing in education, poverty reduction and music education for all children.
- With extra attention for initiatives by young people and international citizens.

**We deliver sustainable solutions by empowering neighbourhoods to take the lead.**

## 4. Democracy in LV - the smart and engaged municipality

- A broad council agreement instead of smaller coalition.
- Focus on neighbourhood empowerment and social cohesion.
- Seriously involving residents in politics and treating them as equals.
- Transparency, open and accessible information, data management in order.
- Better digital services and strong regional cooperation.

## 5. A safe, welcoming and enjoyable living environment

- Safe cycle routes with excellent traffic flow.
- Meeting places and green squares in every neighbourhood.
- Strengthening social safety, with an emphasis on the experience of women.
- Encouraging exercise and health, including safe and accessible open-water swimming in the Vliet.

## +1. Future: made in Europe

- Learning from European examples such as energy cooperatives, housing cooperatives and neighbourhood-led initiatives. Making greater use of European subsidies.
- Volt provides a direct connection between Leidschendam-Voorburg and the rest of Europe.

## Financial

- Maintain a healthy buffer, but avoid excessive accumulation: we invest in a targeted and conscious manner in sustainability, affordable housing, exercise and enjoyment.



# THE COMPASS

## of Volt Leidschendam-Voorburg

**Politics is about making choices. Volt makes those choices by first listening, understanding, weighing up interests and only then deciding.**

**In all our choices, Volt is guided by the following nine principles.**

**1. Volt connects people.**

Choices that bring different groups together matter more than proposals that serve only one group.

**2. Volt trusts the power of residents.**

We value bottom-up initiatives and work differently from the top down, by involving people early and treating participation and co-creation as a condition for success.

**3. Volt applies the human scale.**

We prioritise proximity, human contact and small-scale solutions over anonymous, large-scale systems.

**4. Volt stands for greater equality.**

We choose solutions that reduce inequality and create fairer opportunities for all.

**5. Volt puts people and nature first.**

The well-being of people and the environment outweighs purely economic interests.

**6. Volt prioritises prevention.**

Preventing problems reduces both human suffering and public costs, therefore prevention comes before repair.

**7. Volt chooses integrated solutions.**

We support coherent measures that address multiple challenges at once, avoiding solutions that create new problems elsewhere.

**8. Volt safeguards financial balance.**

Public money must be spent wisely and transparently. Financial reserves are necessary, but excessive accumulation is not.

**9. Volt acts for future generations.**

Long-term benefits take precedence over short-term gains.



### And doesn't Volt also have something to do with Europe?

Volt is active in 32 European countries, making it a pan-European party. This enables essential European cooperation in tackling the shared challenges of our time. Also, this cooperation facilitates the exchange of knowledge and allows us to introduce best practices in our municipality. No empty words, but actions: pragmatic, positive and focused on solutions that work in practice. That's what defines Volt, and what we bring to Leidschendam-Voorburg.
